- Pause & Repeat** We did NOT treat *Eurasian Water Milfoil* last year, but will once again apply Max-G herbicide in June to control this weed.
- Subsidize** OLPOA is eligible for 50% reimbursement of our treatment costs over the next two years, under a grant from the state of WI.
- Budget** We are estimating a **net** cost of \$5,000 for herbicide treatment in 2013. Kristy Maki estimates the *total* cost will be \$12,000.
- Monitor** Wayne will continue to check boats that use the southern landing, as part of a mandatory *Clean Boats/Clean Waters* program.
- Construct** The Carlson Road bridge will soon be replaced, after years of controversy over Round Lake water levels.
